Upcoming and future works

Lake Thomson

Works will commence shortly to construct a new family friendly park alongside Lake Thomson. There will be a range of amenities in the new park, including:

- picnic areas for families
- BBQ facilities
- play equipment
- · footpaths and landscaping.

The park is anticipated to open in late 2022.

Sportsfields precinct

We are constructing the sportsfield precinct which will be handed over to Council to manage when complete. The sportsfields precinct will include two playing fields and pedestrian and cycle pathways. Council will manage access to these fields.

Landscaping works are scheduled to begin in September 2021.

New section of the Macarthur Regional Recreational Trail at Macarthur Heights

We will soon be undertaking works to construct a pathway through our site to connect in with the Macarthur Regional Recreational Trail. Once all sections are complete, the 14km long Macarthur Regional Recreational Trail will extend from Camden town centre, through the Mount Annan botanic gardens, and down to Macarthur railway station.
