Construction update

Stages 4 and 6 Works to deliver 106 private lots in Stage 4A have been completed and we anticipate the subdivision will be registered in the coming weeks. Works to remove the existing underpass and re-construct Riverside Drive are due to be completed by mid-2023.

Stage 6B footpaths and landscaping works continue and are anticipated to be completed in mid-2023. Settlements on all lots are now complete.

Stage 9 Works to deliver 53 lots in Stage 9 are due to commence this month and will take approximately 12 months to complete.

New social housing New 'fit for purpose' social housing is being delivered by LAHC to better meet future resident requirements.

This includes:

- 61 new social homes across Stages 4A, 4B and 6B, due for completion between now and mid 2025. In Stage 6A, 17 homes have already been completed
- 62 dwellings for seniors housing in Stages 4 and 9, expected to be complete in 2025
- a boarding house with eight dwellings in Stage 4, due for completion in 2024.

Construction update

We have experienced delays across parts of our construction program due to the residual impact of a fire at Kevin Wheatley Reserve last November, wet weather and supply chain issues. We thank you for your understanding.

The construction works at Kevin Wheatley Reserve and The Pond have now reached a stage where they are more resilient to rainfall. We look forward to progressing these two projects and returning them to the community.

Please note, construction timings are indicative only and some works are subject to additional approvals.



1 Kevin Wheatley Reserve

Construction works at Kevin Wheatley Reserve are ongoing and involve the installation of drainage pipes, landscaping, new playing fields and a playground. We anticipate works will finish by mid-2024.

2 The Pond

Construction works at The Pond are ongoing and involve dewatering, earthworks and landscaping to build new viewing decks that will provide places for the community to relax. We anticipate works will finish by mid-2024.

3 Riverside Drive

As part of Stage 4 works, Riverside Drive is being realigned to form an easier route to Wheatley Drive. We anticipate Riverside Drive to reopen to through-traffic by mid-2023.

During works, the shopping village and petrol station on Riverside Drive will stay open and directional signage will guide vehicles and pedestrians via a detour.

4 Towner Avenue

Construction works for Towner Avenue West, the new road that will connect Riverside Drive with St Johns Road, are ongoing and should be complete by September 2023.

Construction of a roundabout at the intersection of St Johns Road and Towner Avenue is underway, with works staged to allow traffic to pass through the intersection. These works are anticipated to be completed later this month.

Works at the eastern section of Towner Avenue immediately south of Newbrook Shopping Village will start this month to build a roundabout at the intersection with Riverside Drive. A temporary detour will help customers to access the shopping village car park via its loading dock on Riverside Drive. Further information will be provided prior to works commencing.

These works are anticipated to take approximately six months to complete, pending weather.

Rehousing plan update

Rehousing and demolition activities being undertaken in Airds by the Department of Communities and Justice are progressing well and include:

- Stage 5 cottage areas 17% relocations complete
- Stage 6 and 8 cottage areas 95% relocations complete
- Stage 7A and part 7B redevelopment area 89% relocations complete
- Stage 9 redevelopment area all relocations complete.

Community Reference Group


Want to learn more about works happening in Airds and Bradbury or have ideas on how to make the neighbourhood more vibrant?
