



North Wilton Development Update

Kicking sustainability goals at Panorama

In our last development update we shared some of the features that future homes in Panorama will have that helped us achieve a 6 Star Green Star rating. However, sustainability isn't just about housing, it's also about construction methods and delivery.

We've been working closely with our contractor TRN to convert their site sheds to being fully solar-powered. This means the sheds no longer need to be powered by generators and we have reduced reliance on fossil fuel heavy, grid-supplied energy.

We're also exploring the use of low-carbon asphalt and recycled materials to reduce construction waste and carbon emissions. We'll continue to look for opportunities to reduce our impact, so stay tuned!

Making leaps and bounds on Stage 1

Stage 1 civil works commenced in February and are expected to be completed in late 2023. Over the last few months we've completed sewer works, road pavement, kerbing, retaining walls, stormwater and associated infrastructure.

Upcoming works include electrical, water, and NBN infrastructure, as well as an extension to

Fairway Dive and landscaping. And we're already looking ahead, with Development Applications for Stages 2-4 lodged with Council for assessment and determination.

Stage 1 Work hours and duration

Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm, and Saturdays between 8am and 3pm. We will not work on Sundays or public holidays. Weather and worksite conditions pending, construction for Stage 1 will finish in late 2023.

Panorama will be a place where day to day life feels relaxed, with a network of tree lined streets, great open spaces, natural bushland and community facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy. It will be a future ready place with a choice of energy efficient and affordable homes for people at all stages of life looking to be part of an inclusive and resilient community.

The vision statement details outcomes we'll pursue over the life of the project to promote a community that connects with culture, is resilient, liveable and connected.
