Construction and planning update

Stage 4A All works complete, with 107 build-ready residential lots delivered.

Stage 6B Footpaths and landscaping works complete.

Stage 8 Development application lodged to deliver 80 residential lots, involving demolition works, tree removal, earthworks, installation of utilities and landscaping.

Stage 9 Works to deliver 53 build-ready residential lots are underway, with earthworks due to start next month.

Riverside Drive

Works to realign Riverside Drive next to Stage 4A to create a more comfortable and efficient travel route are complete. We have also extended the shared pedestrian and cycle path along Riverside Drive from Wheatley Drive to south of Towner Avenue.

2 Towner Avenue

The Western part of Towner
Avenue is almost complete and
is anticipated to open by the end
of the year. This new section of
road will connect St Johns Road
through to Partridge Street.
Construction of the final stretch
of Towner Avenue to connect
Partridge Street to Riverside Drive,
south of Newbrook Shopping
Village will commence in mid2024. Residents can still access
the shopping village carpark with
a temporary detour in place.

3 Kevin Wheatley Reserve

Following the fire incident in July, reserve upgrade works have temporarily paused to decontaminate the area. The drainage design for the reserve is also being reviewed to improve its durability and performance. Once complete, the upgraded reserve will include two full-sized soccer fields with synthetic grass and sportsfield lights, an amenities building, play equipment and a half-court basketball court.

4 The Pond

Works to upgrade The Pond have temporarily paused following the recent fire incident and will resume once the area has been decontaminated. Once complete, the pond will be bigger, while new plants, a viewing area, seats and a playground will make the area more attractive.

Rehousing plan update

Rehousing and demolition activities being undertaken in Airds by the Department of Communities and Justice are progressing well and include:

- Stage 5 cottage areas 41% relocations complete
- Stage 6 cottage areas all relocations complete
- Stage 7A and part 7B redevelopment area all relocations complete
- Stage 7B redevelopment area approval received for rehousing in October 2023


Want to know more about Newbrook development works happening in Airds and Bradbury or have ideas on how to make the neighbourhood more vibrant?
