Stage 4 design, including the new stormwater basin design was submitted to Campbelltown Council this month.

Remediation works should start towards the end of this year.

#### Stage 3C

The detailed design for Stage 3C is progressing well, and construction work is expected to begin later this year.

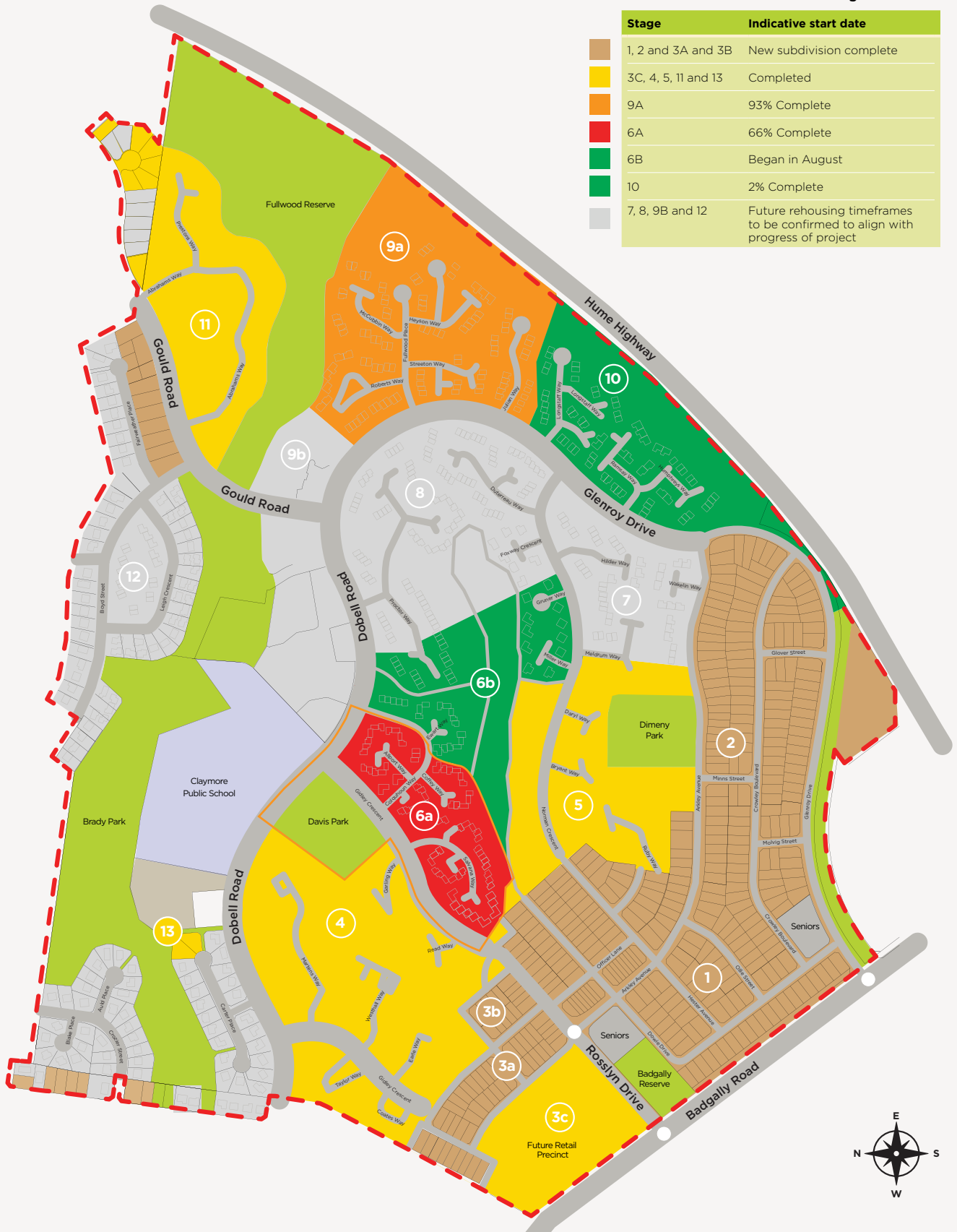
## Rehousing plan
