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## Update on the Macarthur Heights community spaces

### What's happening with the amenities building?

We are finalising the Review of Environmental Factors, which considers the environmental and planning impacts of the proposed amenities building. This will enable us to assess and determine the proposal under Division 5.1 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act.

### What's happening with the sportsfields precinct?

We received approval from Sydney Water to treat the sewerage

infrastructure located below ground in the sportsfields precinct in mid-April and have restarted works to deliver the new sportsfields. Works remain on track to be completed in 2026.


### What's happening with maintenance across Macarthur Heights?


We are continuing to work with Council and Western Sydney University to clarify maintenance responsibilities. Please get in touch if you have any queries.

# New public bus service in Macarthur Heights!

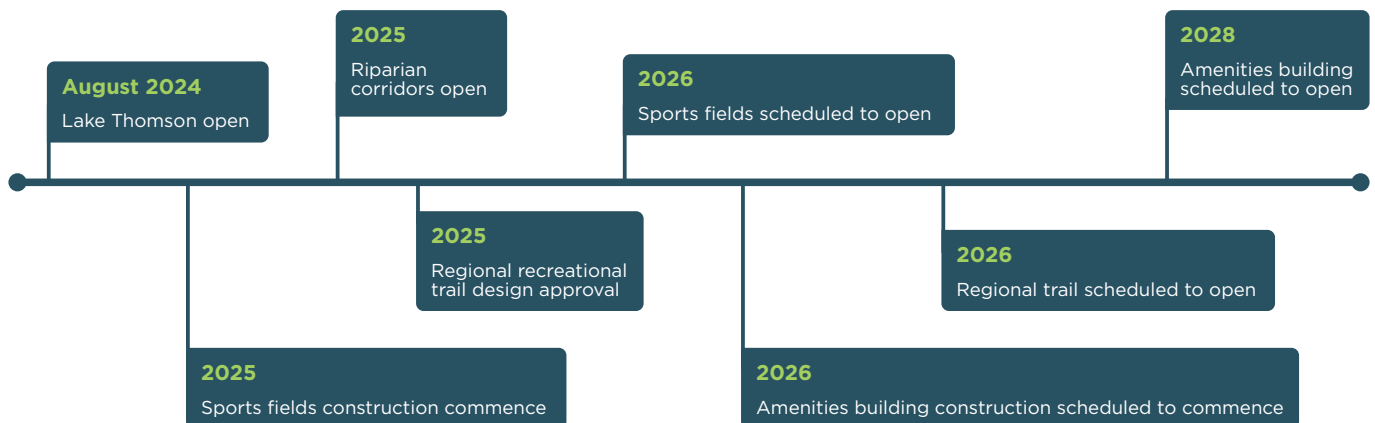

## Planning proposal under assessment

Our planning proposal to amend the approved concept masterplan for Macarthur Gardens North (to allow for an additional 375 apartments) was publicly exhibited between mid-March and early April 2025.

As part of the planning process, we provided a response to submissions to the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure to assist with their assessment.

## Proposal for affordable housing

In response to the NSW Government's commitment to increase the supply of affordable housing under the National Housing Accord, we aim to deliver 1,800 affordable rental dwellings across all our projects by 2029.

As part of our plans for a new sustainable, walkable, and connected neighbourhood in Macarthur, we will be lodging a State Significant Development Application for two residential buildings that will provide 130 affordable rental apartments. These buildings will include a mix of 1-bedroom, 2-bedroom, and 3-bedroom apartments.

On 11 June we held a pop-up information session at Macarthur Square to share information about the application. Community members who dropped in were supportive of more affordable housing in the area, with some concerns raised about local character.

The application will be lodged with the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure in the coming weeks.

## Development application for residential apartments

We have lodged a development application with Campbelltown City Council for 216 homes in two buildings. The application is consistent with the planning proposal currently being assessed.

The buildings will offer a mix of studio, 1-bedroom, 2-bedroom, and 3-bedroom apartments, as well as dual key and accessible apartments. Residents will enjoy high quality shared open spaces and easy access to surrounding services and facilities.

The application was lodged on 4 July 2025 and should be placed on public exhibition in the coming weeks.
