## Temporary changes to pedestrian access connecting to Macarthur Station

**LANDCOM** 

We are planning to start early construction at the Macarthur Gardens North site in the coming months. During early works, pedestrian access through the site to Macarthur Station will change. We know people are concerned about access changes and are exploring opportunities to minimise disruption. Please read page two of this newsletter for more information.



### Macarthur Gardens North update

#### What is approved?

Landcom received approval for the Macarthur Gardens North masterplan in December 2022.

The development will include parks and open spaces, and approximately 1,250 apartments, including studio, 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom apartments, in buildings up to nine storeys high, with provision for at least 10% Affordable Rental Housing.

### **Construction plans**

Construction is anticipated to start in September or October this year, with works delivered in phases to minimise impacts on the community.

We are exploring opportunities to maintain pedestrian access to Macarthur Station in a safe and practical manner wherever possible. For periods when it is not possible to provide pedestrian access during construction works, we plan to provide a shuttle bus service.

The table below shows the indicative timing and duration of the different work phases. Work timing is likely to change as it is subject to approvals and weather.

Planned construction phases	Potential timing and duration of works	Pedestrian access
<b>Phase 1A</b> - bulk earthworks to level and stabilise the site.	Start September/October 2023 Approximately 4 months	Access will remain open for the majority of these works.
<b>Phase 1B</b> – civil works to build roads and install power, water and wastewater services for future development, as well as parks and open spaces.	Start early 2024 Approximately 10 months	Access is likely to be impacted for periods during this stage.
<b>Phase 2</b> – new footbridge works to replace the existing footbridge to meet current design and accessibility standards.	Start mid-late 2025 Approximately 12 months	Access is likely to be impacted for periods during this stage.
<b>Phase 3</b> – new buildings built by future development partners.	From 2025	Access will remain open.

### Did you know?

Levelling and stabilising the site will require large machinery to move the equivalent of over **20 Olympic sized pools of soil** across the site during Phase 1A works



and a further **15 Olympic sized pools of soil** during Phase 1B when construction of roads and infrastructure will start.

### Macarthur Heights update

### Lake Thomson

Works are on schedule to start in September 2023, with construction anticipated to take 12 months to complete. We are in the process of procuring a contractor for these works.

In May of this year, we asked the Macarthur Heights Community Group for feedback on ideas for a new play area and in response we will deliver bespoke play equipment with areas for climbing and sliding, swings, a flying fox, and shade.

### **Sportsfields precinct**

### **Realigning Bow Bowing Creek**

Works to realign Bow Bowing Creek are part of the overall management of stormwater downstream of Lake Thomson, through a series of flood detention basins and channel works.

We are finalising approval from Sydney Water to encase a sewer pipe in concrete. Subject to approvals we plan to recommence this work towards the end of 2023.

### **Playing fields**

Following the completion of Bow Bowing Creek realignment works, landscaping works can recommence and are anticipated to take 12 months to complete.

### **Amenities building**

We received community feedback about the need for an 'all-weather' facility in the Sportsfields precinct for social gatherings and have provided initial options to Campbelltown City Council for consideration.

### Macarthur Regional Recreational Trail

The Macarthur Regional Recreational Trail will pass through Macarthur Heights as part of a 14-kilometre nature trail which will provide a walking and cycling link to Campbelltown Station and the Australian Botanic Garden. We have completed most sections of the trail, except for the connection under the Hume Highway, and the section within the Sportsfields Precinct.

Since our last newsletter, we have received permission from Transport for NSW to survey the area that will connect the trail under the Hume Highway and inform the design of this section.

#### **Bush regeneration**

The five riparian corridors that run through Macarthur Heights are being regenerated for the enjoyment of residents. We anticipate that regeneration works will start in early 2024 and will include:

- removal of weeds and rubbish
- introduction of new native plants
- construction of pedestrian and cycling paths to better connect the neighbourhood.
