

Panorama at North Wilton Community Update



Stage 1 here we come!

We have secured development approval for Stage 1 of Panorama at North Wilton, including 199 residential lots and a 7ha school site. Construction will begin in February 2023.

Panorama will be built and sold in stages in line with planning requirements and housing demand.

With the start of construction we understand some of our neighbours may have questions about how works will be managed. Stage 1 construction access will be via the existing bridge over the Hume Highway at the end of Fairway Drive in Bingara Gorge.

Importantly, most heavy machinery will remain on site until the end of construction to ensure minimal disruptions to Bingara Gorge residents.

A new bridge over the Hume Highway and on/off ramps will be delivered before there are 300 lots at Panorama, which will remove construction traffic from existing residential areas for future stages.

We understand that construction traffic is a challenge for our neighbours. We've got plans in place to reduce the impact of heavy machinery and truck movements.

- Stage 1 construction access will be over the existing bridge at the end of Fairway Drive.
- Most heavy machinery will enter the site once and stay for the entirety of Stage 1 construction to minimise truck movements through Bingara Gorge.
- Landcom is seeking to use a haulage route to minimise heavy traffic movements along Fairway Drive.

We have lodged an application to have Panorama at North Wilton assessed for a 6-Star Green Star Communities rating. This is the highest possible rating under the Green Star Communities Framework with the Green Building Council of Australia and reflects world's best practice sustainability.

What is the Green Star Communities Framework?

The framework is used to assess the planning, design and construction of large development projects on a community scale. Our planning and delivery of Panorama will be independently assessed using a rigorous rating system across five impact categories, including governance, liveability, economic prosperity, environment and innovation.

Over the next 25 years, Landcom will develop up to 514ha of the North Wilton site for 5,600 new homes.

In the next few months look out for:

- appointment of the civil contractor (late 2022)
- Stage 1 sales release (late 2022)
- commencement of Stage 1 construction (February 2023).

Engagement in 2023

Next year, we will be providing new engagement opportunities to help identify urban design principles and inform neighbourhood planning. The Cumberland Plain Conservation Plan

With the advancement of the Cumberland Plain Conservation Plan, Panorama at North Wilton will include an increased conservation area for koala habitat.
