## Community celebrates opening of Dimeny Park skatepark

On 2 November, Dimeny Park came alive as the community gathered to celebrate the opening of its brand-new skatepark with a day full of fun, connection and youth engagement. Around 200 attendees enjoyed the upgraded space and a packed program of free activities that brought families together and encouraged

kids to try skateboarding for the very first time.

The event kicked off with a beautiful Welcome to Country by Aunty Glenda and a Smoking Ceremony by Uncle John, setting a warm and inclusive tone for the day. Families enjoyed skateboarding workshops and demos by Totem Skateboarding, while younger ones enjoyed free

face painting. The sausage sizzle and coffee cart kept everyone fuelled and happy.

Community feedback has been overwhelmingly positive, with families and Council praising how well organised and welcoming the event felt. The vibe was incredible. Everyone was eager to learn, participate and celebrate this new space.

## Housing construction and sales

### Stage 6

Campbelltown Council approved the development application in early October. Construction works should begin in early 2026.

### Stage 4

Remediation works remain on track for completion by early 2026 and we expect to start civil works this year.

### Stage 3C and 5

There are no further updates. All lots have now settled.

### Dimeny Park

Dimeny Park was completed in October 2025 and opened to the public in November 2025.

### Davis Park

We have removed goal posts at Davis Park to make way for future upgrades, which will include a multi-purpose junior cricket and soccer field, a seating area and a new amenities block.

Residential relocations for Stages 6A, 6B, 8 and 10 are progressing. Rehousing relocations for Stage 7 are expected to begin in mid-late 2026. Residents will get plenty of notice about their moving plans.
