Housing construction and sales

Stage 4

Since the last update, we’ve installed new electrical and communication services along Dobell Road and continued building retaining walls and roads within the site. Road paving was completed last month, with works expected to be finished in November 2026.

Stage 6

Demolition and remedial works are continuing on site. Gidley Crescent remains closed and will be reconstructed as part of Stage 6 works.

Stage 9

Subdivision works are progressing well, with completion proposed later in 2026. Once complete, this stage will pave the way for new homes to take shape.

Stage 10

Subdivision works are now underway.

Stage 13

Subdivision works for Stage 13 have recently been completed and the subdivision is pending final registration.

Fullwood Reserve

Works have started on site for the park upgrade at Fullwood Reserve, which will include a retention basin and a kick-about field. These upgrades will bring new opportunities for recreation and play to this much-loved community space.

Retail centre

The retail centre site has been sold to a developer, with a development application to be lodged soon. Expressions of interest for the retail component are underway, with potential

tenants including a supermarket, gym, food outlets and a swim school.

Davis Park

Planning for Davis Park continues to move forward. Detailed design is progressing well, and we remain on track for park improvements to start later this year.

Brady Park

Upgrades are continuing at Brady Park. Work on the stormwater basin and footpath realignment is progressing, with the basin due for completion later this month. The footpath remains temporarily closed until October 2026 while this work takes place.
